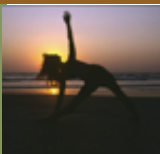

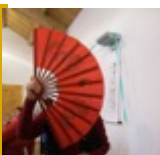

Coppicing Conference

More than 50 people attended the Coppicing Conference last month, run by the Scottish Crannog Centre as part of their Perthshire Coppice Project. The aim of the conference was to establish a closer networking of people involved in coppicing, woodland crafts, conservation work and woodland management.

Talks over two days covered many topics, from coppicing in Fife, Cumbria, Helmsdale and Loch Tay, Lichens in Atlantic Hazelwoods, Coppice with Standards, Biodiversity of Coppice Woodlands, Woodland History, Woodland Ownership and the labeling of woodland products. Two of the coppice sites around Loch Tay were also visited.
