Jess's illustrated book of short stories springs from the psyche of a touring artist, finding romance in pylons, transport systems, and concrete. She writes gutsy modern folk songs telling stories full of sadness and bite. Nels Andrews, based in Santa Cruz, California, is a journeyman in the craft of melody who is here to tell you a story. His new record Pigeon & the Crow comes with a graphic novella in which Nels' supernatural ballads sprawl the pages with colourful illustrations by artist Mike Benzce. "Nels is a master carver, an artist patient and obsessed enough to turn a whale of an idea into something delicate and beautiful from any angle." – Anais Mitchell.


