## Using The Big Shed itself

**1. Plumbing system**. The Big Shed is not on mains sewage & the narrow pipes can easily be blocked by wet wipes , tampons, wet toilet tissue wipes etc. Please be careful about what you flush.

**2.** Hot water, heating & shower. The immersion heater is in the hall cupboard. Instruction are beside it. The shower is not electric, so needs the water in the tank to be hot first. It will break if you try to turn the temperature up and there's no hot water.

3. Cooking – Instructions are on the metal casing for the air intake above the butchery bench

**4. Cleaning/disposal of rubbish** – Please separate rubbish for recycling and landfill – details of the policy for Perthshire are on the wall in the lobby & on the bins. Please take glass away with you.

5 • Breakages & Damage - We don't charge for wear & tear breakages, but please let us know as we may need to fix or replace it before the next group arrives. Other damage must be reimbursed.

5. Lost property –. If you leave something, let us know & and we will keep it until you can collect it.

## Respecting the farm and the local residents

**1. Park in** the designated Parking Areas, leaving the yard for residents & shop customers. (in winter the track may occasionally be too slippery to drive safely. Cars may have to be left at the end of the track in car park 3 or 4 ).

**2**. **Unload** outside the building, then move the vehicle to a car park immediately. The house further down the hill needs access to the track - do not block it - day or night.

**3. Noise at night.** There are houses very close to the Big Shed. Please respect residents' need to sleep! Keep the hall doors properly shut after 11pm. No amplified music after midnight.

**4. Play equipment & firepit** — are owned by local residents & are not available to the general public. The owners are happy for you to use the equipment at your own risk, but adults should carry out an informal risk assessment before allowing children to play there and **MUST ACTIVELY SUPERVISE** them. Damage must be paid for.

Note that the weight limit on the trampoline is 120kg which is about 5 kids or 2 smallish adults. Please don't exceed this: it may damage the trampoline or more importantly you/your children. Hospital is a long way. Don't risk it!

**5. Residents' property** – do not "borrow" items/allow children in the group others to help themselves to items that are not in the Big Shed. They will belong to residents and will be on residents' own property.

## 6. Tombreck is a working farm

Do not feed any of the animals Farms are dangerous places. Items of farm machinery are not toys. Do not play with them or allow others to do so

The following are also not permitted.

Dogs – except assistance dogs.

Fireworks

Nerf guns/similar sprayers of little bits of plastic that are a risk to animals and pollute the land
